In this class we've learned how to correctly prompt AI for the best results needed for us. This one was targeted towards automotive companies looking to hire a mechanic. I told Chat GPT to highlight the attributes that would work best in my favor for the instance an automotive business would view my resume. For the third and final resume, I told Chat GPT to direct the resume towards a small drywall company looking for a project manager, and to highlight the best attributes I have to work in my favor. I also gave it some more information to add into the resume, like some old experience I have hanging drywall working for my dad in the past. Hopefully these resumes have not only shown my skills needed to obtain my job, but also skills needed to correctly prompt AI for the best.
